Registration-Waiver Form

SRA requires that each player complete a two page registration form. For players under 18 years of age a legal guardian must sign the Waiver Form.

For your convenience, visit our website to print and complete the form before registration.

All fees must be paid at the time of registration unless using the SRA payment plan as set out below.

SRA Registration Payment Plan: \$100.00 cash or cashable cheque per player is due at registration with the balance due in near equal monthly installments (maximum of 4 postdated cheques dated no later than December 31st)

Note:

- Non-registered players trying out for A and AA teams only, will be charged \$100.00.
- NSF Charge - \$25.00 per cheque.
- Administration Fee of \$25.00 will be applied against all refunds.
- Prorated refunds are considered on an individual basis.

The Saskatoon Wild will be participating in the Western Division of the NRL again this season. As one of the founding franchises in the NRL, the Wild will compete with the Manitoba Jets, Winnipeg Prairie Fire, Calgary Rath, Edmonton Wam, and the new franchise this year, the Lower Mainland Thunder. Conference reps will participate in the Canadian Ringette Championships in Burnaby, BC in April 2012.

The majority of the players on the Wild are students, both in Saskatoon and Regina. It is a credit to these student athletes that they are able to balance their studies as well as competing in a very high performance league like the NRL. The Wild roster is made up of many elite athletes including Olympic athlete Erin Cumpstone as well as many AA players and Canada Winter Games participants. The league Schedule includes home and home three game series with each of the teams in our division for a total of 30 games during the year. Tryouts for the Wild will take place in September and the first series home series for the team will be the second weekend in November.
